

7,s With 5 or 6 Players

With 5 players, use one deck of cards (no jokers).

Put 7 spades and 7 hearts on the table. Each player is delt 10 cards. The player left of dealer will start the game. Deal is once around table.

When playing with money, each player will ante 2 quarters. Player with low score after each deal wins one quarter. Player with total low score at end of game wins remaining 5 quarters.

With 6 players, use two decks of cards (no jokers).

Put one 7 spades and one 7 hearts on the table. Each player is delt 17 cards. The player left of dealer will start the game. Deal is once around table.

When playing with money, each player will ante 2 quarters. Player with low score after each deal wins one quarter. Player with total low score at end of game wins remaining 6 quarters.

Order of play with either 5 or 6 players

Player to left of dealer then plays either a 6 or 8 of spades or another 7 of any suit. Play up or down on any 7 to King high or Ace low. You can play a 7 any time but you cannot play higher or lower than the 7 pile prior to it on the table. If unable to play then the player to their left gives a card of their choice from their hand to that player.

Example - The 7 of spades and 7 of hearts are on the table. The player after the dealer played the 6 of spades. The next player can play only the 8 of spades, the 5 of spades, the 6 of hearts or another 7 of any suit. If unable to play then the player to their left will give a card of their choice from their hand. At no time can a card be played higher or lower than the 7 pile prior to it on the table.

The first player that gets rid of all their cards wins that hand. All other players add up the point total of the cards remaining in their hand. The point total of each hand is totaled together and lowest point total at end of game wins.

Card point count - 2 thru 7 = 5 points

8 thru K = 10 points

Ace = 20 points
