

Hand and Foot

Any number of players can play.

- Individual, playing only on your own spread
- guys against gals, alternating guy and gal seating, one spread for the guys and one spread for the gals
- pairs, sitting across from each other, each pair would have a spread

Hand - 13 cards Playing all cards in hand before playing foot
Foot - 11 cards

To get down on the table.

1 st round -	50 points
2 nd round -	90 points
3 rd round -	120 points
4 th round -	150 points

To go out, playing all your cards, do not have to discard, you need

- One Red Book = 7 natural cards
- Two Black Books = 7 cards, at least one wild card, no more than 3 wild cards

- Black book - must have more naturals than wild cards while creating your book of seven cards.
- Must have 2 naturals in your hand to pick up the top seven cards of pile.
 - If you are not already down, you can only use the top card for points to get down. Once you have established your points, you can use any of the other cards. Otherwise you cannot take the cards if you can't get down.
 - If you are already down, you can use any of the seven cards on your books.
- Three's cannot be made into books.
- Do not have to discard to go out.

Point system

Red 3 500 points against you
Black 3 100 points against you

Joker	50
Duce	20
Aces	20
8 - K	10
7 - 4	5
Red book	500
Black book	300
	100 extra points for the one who goes out

Scoring Sample

1200	= 1 red book(500), 2 black books(600), and 100 for going out
+ 515	= Total points on table
1715	
- 100	= subtract any points your partner was left with
1615	= Total Points for that round

Highest score of the four rounds is winner.
