

## SEQUENCE

Special board is used for this game

### The Deal

Use two decks of cards plus two extra jokers and four extra jacks for up to 6 players. For 8 players, use an additional deck of cards. Poker chips of the same color should be divided among partners.

Deal 5 cards to each player.

Divide the remaining cards into equal stack to draw from during play. One stack should be available to every 2 players.

### The Play

The player to the left of the dealer shall remove a card from his hand, lay it face up on the table and place a chip on the board over the corresponding card. Immediately thereafter, the player should take a card from the draw pile so that he will always have 5 cards to play with.

A "Sequence" is made when a player or partners have 5 chips in a row, either horizontal, vertical, or diagonal. Two "Sequences" complete the game. When a sequence is complete, chips are turned over to reveal the special mark or double stacked and it is then not possible to remove any chips from the sequence. Only one chip from a previous sequence can be used to make the second sequence. Opponents cannot cross a completed sequence in order to make a sequence.

### Rules of Play

Talking across the board that will help a partner decide where to place his chip is strictly forbidden.

Jacks with one eye may be used to remove an opponent's chip.

Jacks with two eyes may be used to place a chip anywhere.

Jokers are wild and may be used to place a chip anywhere, or may be used to remove an opponent's chip.

The jokers on the board do not need to be covered in order to make a sequence but are a free place.
